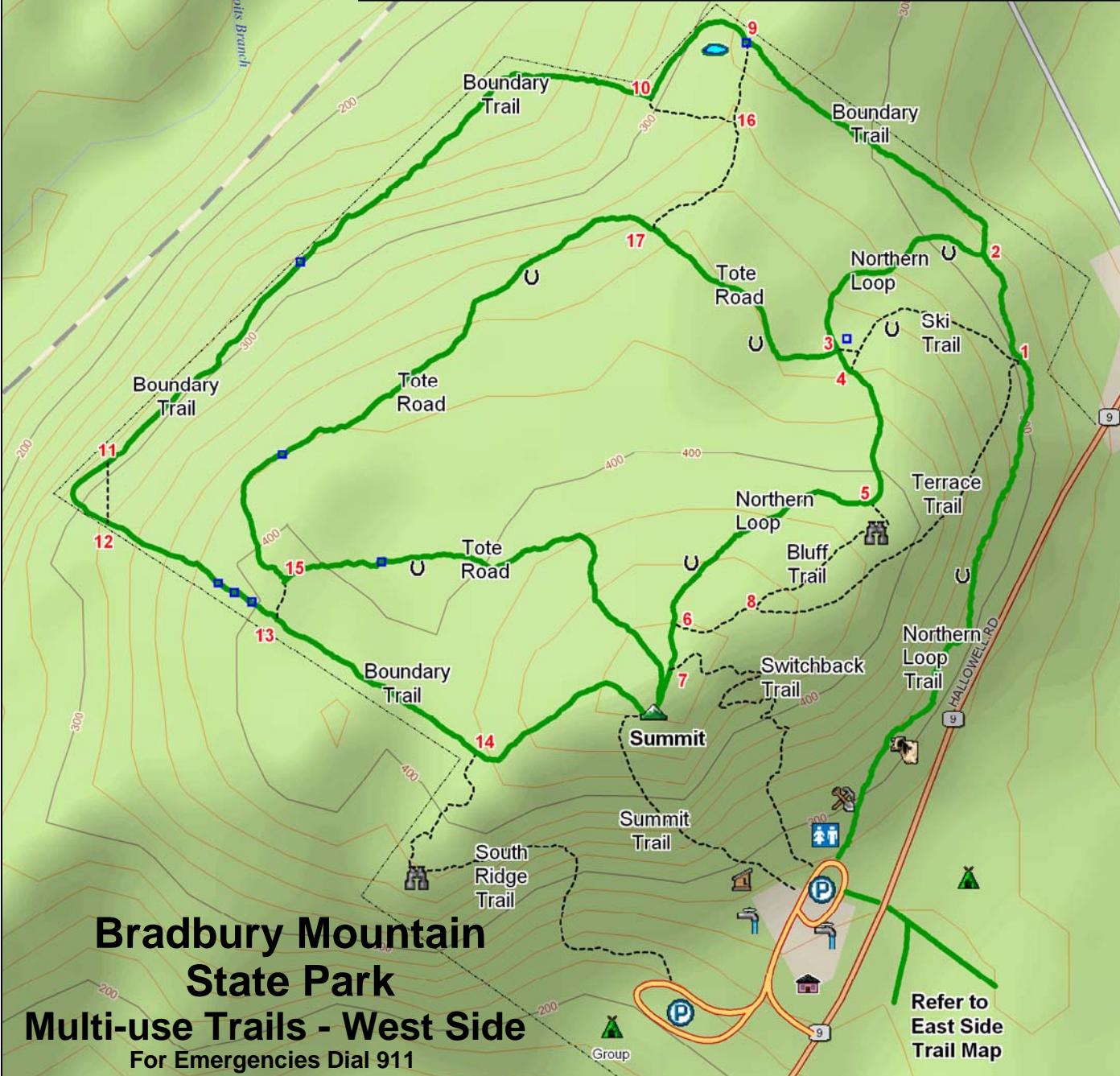


Trail Name	Blaze Color	Length (Miles)	Difficulty					Trail Description
Northern Loop	Blue	1	●	■	■	■	×	Wide; gradual ascent to summit
Summit	White	0.3	■	×	×	×	×	Steepest ascent, but not a difficult hike
Bluff	Red	0.2	●	×	×	×	×	Fairly flat
Tote Road	White	1	●	●	●	●	×	Flat, wide, mile loop
Boundary	Orange	1.5	■	◆	◆	◆	×	Steep areas, sharp turns, icy in winter
Ski	Green	0.2	●	■	■	■	×	Short gradual ascent
Terrace	Gray	0.3	●	×	×	×	×	Wide, well packed, gradual ascent
South Ridge	Red	0.5	■	×	×	×	×	Some steep areas with ladder ascents
Switchback	None	0.3	■	×	×	×	×	Very steep, sharp turns
